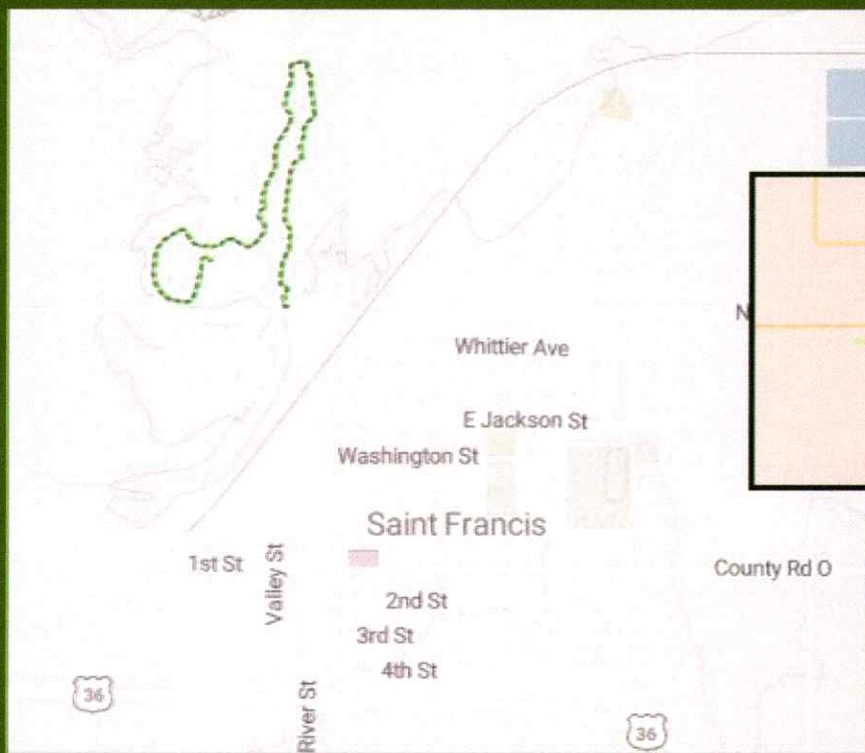
Keller Pond and Scenic Republican River Walk are located just a half mile northwest of downtown St. Francis. The area is a quick stop from the **Land and Sky Scenic Byway** on Highways 36 and 27.

Keller Pond features an 5/8 mile ADA Trail complete with rest stops and shade. It's the perfect place for a picnic and a stroll to enjoy area wildlife. With proper fishing licenses, fishing is allowed in the pond, and it is stocked in the Spring by the local Cheyenne County Wildlife, Inc. in preparation for an annual "Huck Finn" youth fishing day and sportsman tournament.

The adjacent **Scenic Republican River Walk** offers a nature trail approximately 1 mile in length. A foot path (not ADA accessible) links the River Walk to Keller Pond. Enjoy the sounds of the flowing water, birds, and nearby cattle and horses as you hike next to the river and cross a foot bridge.

After a day of exploring these nature areas, enjoy all that **St. Francis** and **Cheyenne County** have to offer!
